## President

The president will be the chief elected officer of the Chapter and, subject to the direction of the Chapter Board of Directors, will have general responsibility for the affairs and property of the Chapter and general supervision over its other Officers and agents. The president will perform all duties incident to the office of President and will see that all orders and resolutions of the Chapter Board of Directors are implemented.

## Specific Responsibilities

- Serves as the President of the FPA Austin chapter and as a member of the chapter board. Serve as an ambassador for our Chapter and the Financial Planning Association.
- Promotes the Financial Planning Association and Chapter mission and purpose.
- Responsibilities begin with the organization of the Annual Strategic Planning Meeting. Provide strategic vision for the Chapter, creating initiatives and goals. Confirm all returning board members and work with President-Elect to find new board members.
- Presides over all board meetings. Prepare agenda, set up zoom, distribute accordingly.
- Meet or contact each board member to assist and serve as a resource for them to offer mentorship, leadership and support of their goals.
- Has general and active management responsibilities for the activities of the chapter and ensures that all orders and resolutions of the Board of Directors are carried out.
- With the Treasurer, Prepare the Chapter budget and membership dues proposal for the current year.
- Read and understand communications from FPA National.
- Conducts the overall greeting and introductions during the FPA Austin Chapter Meetings.
  - Prepare introduction, special announcements
  - Recognize Partners
- Help prepare the incoming President to lead the Chapter to ensure a smooth and orderly transition for the chapter leadership.
- Provides ready-to-go content to Chapter Executive for website, invites, surveys and newsletter
- Serves as head of the Compensation Committee to determine the Chapter Executive's Salary and Bonus.
