Scholarship Award

The Greater Indiana chapter is pleased to announce one \$2,000 scholarship to support attendance to FPA's Residency program.

The money will be put toward the recipient's choice of Residency session (November 2022 or 2023 TBD).

FPA Residency Program

The FPA Residency program is a unique, highly acclaimed, intensive, week-long, experiential-learning program designed to immerse newly or soon-to-be certified CFP® professionals in practicing the "art of financial planning." Led by a faculty of highly experienced and nationally known deans and mentors, program participants or residents spend their days role-playing and working through real-life financial planning scenarios.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, an applicant must be:

- A member of the FPA of Greater Indiana
- Eligible to sit for the CFP Certification Examination *or* have held the CFP designation for 3 years or less

- Proof of eligibility to sit for the CFP Exam or proof of holding the CFP designation for 3 years or less
