

Pro Bono Director - Role & Responsibilities

The Pro Bono Director leads the chapter's efforts to connect financial planning practitioners with individuals, families, and communities in need. This role ensures that FPA Austin fulfills its mission to expand access to financial planning and support meaningful volunteer engagement among members.

1. Leadership & Chapter Engagement

- Promotes the mission and purpose of the Financial Planning Association and the Austin Chapter.
- Attends monthly Board meetings, chapter meetings, and chapter activities.
- Supports the efforts of other Board members and participates in chapter programs and events.

2. Oversight of Pro Bono Initiatives

- Oversees all chapter Pro Bono activities and ensures they align with FPA's standards and community needs.
- Attends Pro Bono calls organized by the FPA National Office to stay informed on best practices and national initiatives.
- Helps keep the chapter aligned with the FPA Austin vision, mission, and goals through Pro Bono engagement.

3. Member Engagement & Recognition

- Tracks and maintains records of members' Pro Bono hours.
- Provides content to the Chapter Executive for newsletters and communications that recognize and celebrate members' Pro Bono contributions.
- Encourages member participation in Pro Bono opportunities and highlights the impact of their work.
